Tompkins County supports individuals in their efforts to live self-sufficient and productive lives.

Alcohol & Drug Council of Tompkins County

The Outpatient Clinic Program provides alcohol and drug use evaluations, psychiatric consultation, medication management and monitoring, and individual chemical dependency counseling.

- 11,689 units of service were provided to 2,192 unique clients
- 73% discontinued use of chemical substances
- 80% reduction in arrests 6 months after admission
- Average length of time in treatment is 3 months for clients with a diagnosis of abuse, and 8-12 months for a diagnosis of dependence

Family & Children's Service

The Children's Mental Health Program offers a broad range of confidential, high quality, affordable counseling, psychiatric, and crisis services to children from infancy through late adolescence and their families.

- 1,864 clients were served and 29,000 appointments offered
- 91% of clients who filled out the satisfaction survey reported that their concerns were understood by their counselor

Gadabout Transportation Service, Inc.

Gadabout Transportation Services uses a fleet of 27 buses with a staff of both paid and volunteer drivers to provide rides for all purposes to Tompkins County residents 60 years of age and older and people with disabilities.

- 63,714 one-way rider trips in 2010
- 12,218 one-way riders were using wheelchairs
- 449,263 miles traveled
- 25 volunteer drivers that donated \$113,151 worth of services

Alcohol & Drug Council Success Story:

"I have a daughter that has been abusing drugs since she was 13, although I only realized the problem last year. We tried finding suitable rehabilitation centers, but until she wanted it, they would not accept her. Being referred to the Alcohol Drug Council was a godsend. The staff has been knowledgeable, compassionate, and dedicated. My daughter has been off drugs for almost 3 months now. We are starting to see the daughter we thought we had lost. We are so grateful for their caring treatment."
