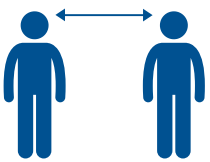
One gift supporting **49 local nonprofits** providing **79 programs** to our community.

EASE OF GIVING AND CHOICE IN GIVING

When you give through UWTC, you have multiple options to plan your giving for the year. You can sign up for our payroll deduction plan through your employer and have a specified amount taken out of every paycheck. You can also schedule payments to be automatically applied to any debit or credit card, or you can pledge to send in a payment at a specific time, such as end of the year, or tax season. We will even remind you! These scheduled gifts can fit **your** lifestyle while making a difference.



AGENCIES CAN LEVERAGE YOUR GIFT

When you give or make pledge through UWTC, agencies are informed of the total amount of UWTC pledges, including yours, for the year. Your gift becomes part of their annual budget, and they can present it as matching funds when applying for grants and other funding.
