

## UWTC OUTCOME STATEMENTS

### HEALTH

#### Accessibility

- Uninsured single adults, seniors and families have access to age appropriate and coordinated health care (including mental and dental care)
- Individuals will have transportation / access to medical services
- Outreach materials will be provided through educational approaches related to health needs and accessibility of services
- Students will receive personal safety information to help make informed decisions
- v. Individuals will report that their concerns are understood by their mental health provider

#### Elders

- Seniors and individuals with disabilities and their caretakers will have a range of supportive services.
- Seniors will experience improved health
- Seniors will have access to cultural activities
- Seniors will develop better supportive relationships, friendships and sense of community
- Participants will experience increased dexterity / hand-eye coordination and balance

#### Family/Children

- Families will increase usage of affordable health care services, including dental care
- Parents will make informed choices regarding diet, exercise, and chronic disease prevention
- Youth will demonstrate consistent preventative health care, improving parenting skills, and strengthen parent/child bonding
- Families will have information about community resources that can address the needs of their children

#### Food/Nutrition

- Children will have access to fresh fruits and vegetables and daily meals
- Families, seniors and single adults will have access to an adequate quantity of quality food
- Families, seniors and single adults will have access to daily, weekly, bi-monthly, and monthly meals
- Program participants will learn how to grow their own food
- Program participants will improve their food preparation skills

### Crisis/Abuse

- Victims of violence or abuse will be provided safe shelter
- Those who stay in shelters will be provided eviction prevention services
- People in imminent danger will receive help
- Youth child sexual abuse and domestic violence clients will disclose abuse and receive support services
- Members of the community will receive prevention information about sexual and domestic abuse
- Individuals, families and couples who have a conflict will attempt a cooperative resolution

### Environment

- The identity and character of communities is maintained
- Significant cultural heritage, scenic and natural landscape elements are conserved and enhanced
- Park and recreation facilities are available for use by the general public
- Community safety and wellbeing is protected through the avoidance or management of natural hazards
- Individuals will increase their participation in activities and their investment in their community

## FINANCIAL STABILITY

### Self-Sufficiency (Disadvantaged Groups Emphasis)

- Home repairs will be made for low-income seniors and disabled clients to become more self-sufficient
- Families, seniors and single adults in Tompkins County will attain stable housing
- Adults will increase their ability to manage their finances
- Provide support and services to incarcerated individuals and their families

### Unemployment

- Unemployed and underemployed adults will gain skills to advance in their employment to attain economic self-sufficiency
- Unemployed and underemployed adults obtain and retain employment leading to attaining economic self-sufficiency

### Basic Needs and Emergencies

- Families, seniors and single adults in Tompkins County have access to emergency supportive housing
- Families, seniors and single adults will avoid evictions, utility shutoffs, and transportation issues due to financial emergencies

- Clients will receive counsel and advice regarding legal problems or questions
- Our agency will increase its ability to respond to any disaster event that occurs in our area

## EDUCATION

### Academic Support and Accessibility

- Youth will be able to secure resources and access information
- Youth will have safe after school programs
- Youth will have a safe place for fun and healthy recreational activities to embrace their development
- Children in Tompkins County will receive affordable, quality childcare services
- Individuals increase their knowledge of services, benefits, civic processes or educational opportunities

### Learning (Early Stage Emphasis)

- Parents, caretakers and guardians will more effectively support children's development
- Youth in Tompkins County will learn new skills
- Children will be socially and emotionally ready to learn when they reach kindergarten
- Individuals will improve their ability to speak, write, and understand vocational English

### Career Preparation

- Youth will show progress toward a degree, and/or obtain employment
- Youth will increase their knowledge of career exploration and employment
- Youth will learn about job skills opportunities for at-risk teens
- Increase the number of middle and high school students prepared for post-secondary success

### Disadvantaged Groups (Circumstantial Improvement)

- Immigrants increase their knowledge of services, benefits, civic processes or educational opportunities
- Immigrants will improve their ability to speak, write, and understand vocational English
- People of all ages are educated about people with disabilities to break down attitudinal, architectural and programmatic barriers
