Catholic Charities Tompkins/Tioga	Transportation Assistance	Supported transportation needs of vulnerable members of the community; going directly to program participants, assisting with transportation services such as car repairs, gas vouchers, and bus passes.	\$4,000.00
Finger Lakes Toy Library	Prioritizing Inclusive Toys and Playtimes	Funded the purchase of inclusive toys for children with disabilities and toys that are representative of the diversity of our community. Also supports dedicated play times at GIAC and Southside CC.	\$2,582.00
Foodnet Meals on Wheels	Blizzard Box Program 2022	Supported the continuation of the Blizzard Box Program for vulnerable older adults who have difficulty maintaining adequate nutrition.	\$6,670.00
